

THINGS TO DO ...

- **Spencer's Butte:** take Willamette St south out of town
→ nice walk and great view
- **Skinner's Butte:** just across from downtown
→ short walk to a parking lot, view over city center, rock-climbing possibility
- **Saturday Market:** downtown, every Saturday from March to November from 10 am to 4 pm, A BIG MUST, EUGENE LIVE
- **Alton Baker Park:** northbank of Willamette river
→ nice walking, biking, canoeing, picnic sheds
- **Ufo Outdoor Program:** EMU
→ day and weekend trips throughout the whole year
→ discover Oregon and make new friends
- **Oregon Coast:** take highway 126 west to Florence
→ walk through the desert of the Oregon Sand Dunes
→ Florence: eat clam chowder at "Mo's" and have ice cream just across "Mo's"
- **Skiing:**
 - **Willamette Pass:** just 1.5 hours from Eugene
→ nice for a daytrip, reasonably priced, trips offered by sport shops like ULLR on Coburg Rd or BERG'S, including skiing pass and rentals
 - **Hoodoo:** 2 hours from Eugene
→ night skiing, but just easy slopes
→ accommodation: Black Butte Ranch
 - **Mt. Bachelor:** 3 hours from Eugene
→ more expensive, but great variety of slopes from easy to challenging
→ accommodation: Sunriver Resort, rent a cozy house with spa
- **Theatre:**
 - **Hult Center for the Performing Arts**, 7th & Willamette
→ order the newsletter via email and get special offers like two tickets for the price of one
 - **University Theatre** on campus
- **Movies:**
 - **Cinemark 12**, 2850 Gateway St, Gateway Mall, Springfield
 - **Cinemark 17**, 900 Gateway Blvd, Gateway Mall, Springfield
→ Each Wednesday, movies for USD 1!
 - **Cinema World 8**, 1087 Valley River Way, Valley River Center, Eugene
 - **Bijou**, 492 E 13th Ave, Eugene
→ alternative movies, cheap in the afternoon
→ old church, special atmosphere
- **University Sports:**
 - Football at Autzen Stadium: GO DUCKS – A MUST, free tickets, but long Lines
 - Baseball (EMS-Games) the American kind of „beergarden“ event ... sitting outdoors, drinking beer, and eating tasty (greasy) food
 - Basketball, Tennis, Volleyball, Softball...
- **OnTheRocks:** a capella university choir, from modern hits over gospel to oldies

EATING AND DRINKING OUT

- **Glenwood Restaurant:** 1340 Alder or 2588 Willamette
→ breakfast, lunch and dinner, cheap and yummy
- **Rennie's Landing:** next to campus 1214 Kincaid
→ American food: burger, beer and more, pool table
- **McMennamins:**
 - High Street Brewery and Café: 1243 High St: beer garden
 - McMennamins Northbank: 22 Club Rd: located at Willamette River
→ nice outdoor seating
 - East 19th Street Café: 1485 E 19th
→ American food: burger, beer and more
- **Taylor's:** on 13th Ave, across bookstore
→ special cocktail nights, pool tables, popular among undergrad students
- **Max's:** 13th Ave, four blocks east of campus
→ pool table, beer, hot-dogs and popcorn for free
- **Hana's:** Alder St
→ Korean food, cheap, quick and good lunch, but lack of atmosphere
- **Zenon Café:** 898 Pearl St
→ French cuisine, nice atmosphere, real French bread without sourdough, good wine
- **Steelhead Brewery:** 199 E 5th Ave
→ burgers, beer and more, try the sampler
- **Misako** – Japanese Restaurant and Sushi Bar: 5 E 8th Ave
→ reasonably priced, very nice atmosphere and very good food
- **6th Street Grill:** 55 W 6th Ave
→ Tuesdays beer and burger \$5
- **Shiki:** 81 Coburg Rd → very good, but expensive
- **Beppe&Gianni's Trattoria:** 1646 E 19th → good Italian food
- **La Perla, 1313 Pearl St,** (same owner as Beppe&Gianni's) → best pizza in town
- **Broadway, 200 W Broadway** → good and reasonably priced wine and more
- **Davies, 94 W Broadway** → café with dancing (Salsa as well as Techno) and good international food

Coffee and Ice Cream:

- **Café Roma:** 13th Ave, east of campus → good coffee
- **Ben&Jerry's:** 1239 Alder St → ice cream
- **Prince Puckler's Ice Cream:** 1605 E 19th → best ice cream in town
- **Pearl Street Ice Cream Parlour:** 1313 Pearl St
- **Café Vero:** 205 E 14th Ave → nice atmosphere
- **Wandering Goat:** 268 Madison St → huge selection of coffee, nice place to meet Eugene's hippies

→ cheap and good wine for USD 3!!!
→ "real" mozzarella, good salami, even German Lebkuchen
- **Safeway**, 145 E 18th or 1500 Coburg Rd

- **Eugene City Bakery**, 1607 E 19th → real bread!!!, best bakery in town

→ Trader Joe's, Borders (books, CDs...) and more

- good Asian restaurant
- near Steelhead brewery and Joe Federigo's

GOING OUT AT NIGHT ...

- **Joe Federigo's**: 5th Ave near Steelhead Brewery
→ cozy jazz club, good live music
→ join the musicians or just enjoy the music
→ drinking and also eating possible (not the best food in town)
- **Diabolos/Downtown Lounge**: Pearl St, near the Greyhound station
→ disco, pool tables, live music (access from 18 years on → lots of youngsters)
- **Tsunami**: 2222 Centennial Blvd
→ disco (hip-hop), Friday night all you can eat/drink 'till midnight, Eugene's only gay club
- **Rock'n Rodeo**: 44 E 7th → disco (hip-hop), popular among undergrad students (see Tayler's)
- **Joggers's**: 710 Willamette → karaoke
- **Wetlands**: 922 Garfield → billiard bar
